Your child will be with a caring clinician who is focused on the goals laid out in the ITP and parent or caregiver's input. Treatment is based upon best practices using a variety of tools, techniques, and training. Therapies may include behavioral, play, and relational.

A typical day may include, but not be limited to: Relationship Building, Intensive Skills Training, Play Therapy, Communication Skills, Group Therapy and Skills,

Peer Play, Gym Time, Daily Living Skills, and Snack/Lunch.

Children may qualify for HFS services with a mental health diagnosis on the Autism Spectrum or after being assessed at the center.
